



WELCOME BACK TO THE LIBRARY

**The Mount Kisco Public Library
will be reopening to the public on
Tuesday, July 7th**

In order to open safely for both our staff and our patrons,
the following measures will occur:

ENTERING/CAPACITY

- A MAXIMUM OF TWENTY FIVE (25) patrons are allowed in the building at one time
- All entering the building will be required to wear masks. The library will not provide masks.
- Doors will remain locked, staff will monitor the doors, and allow entry per the maximum capacity
- A maximum of 5 patrons in children's room
- Areas closed to the public - upstairs large & small meeting rooms, study cubicles and study rooms, downstairs reading, teen & children's activity rooms

COMPUTER USE

- No computers will be available in the teen & children's rooms

- Two (2) adult computers upstairs available with a 30 minute limit
- One (1) Census computer available upstairs

FACILITY USE

- Special Hours for elderly and vulnerable will be 10-11, Monday-Saturday
- Closing one hour early each day to clean
 - Monday & Tuesday 10am-5pm
 - Wednesday & Thursday 10am - 6pm
 - Friday 10am - 4pm
 - Saturday 10am - 3pm
 - Sunday - Closed
- No public restrooms
- No drinking fountains
- No toys, stuffed animals, etc. will be out for use in the children's room
- No magazines or newspapers
- No charging stations
- No furniture/seating areas
- Staff reserves the right to limit a patron's time in the building to 30 minutes to allow other's to come in
- No in person programming - select storytimes will be held outside or virtually
- No book donations until further notice

AVAILABLE OR LIMITED SERVICES

- Copy/Scanner

- Bookdrop
- Service desks will be fully staffed
- Holds/item requests

OTHER

- Fines will resume July 13
- Borrowing books from other libraries resume July 1
- Books returned will be quarantined for 72 hours
